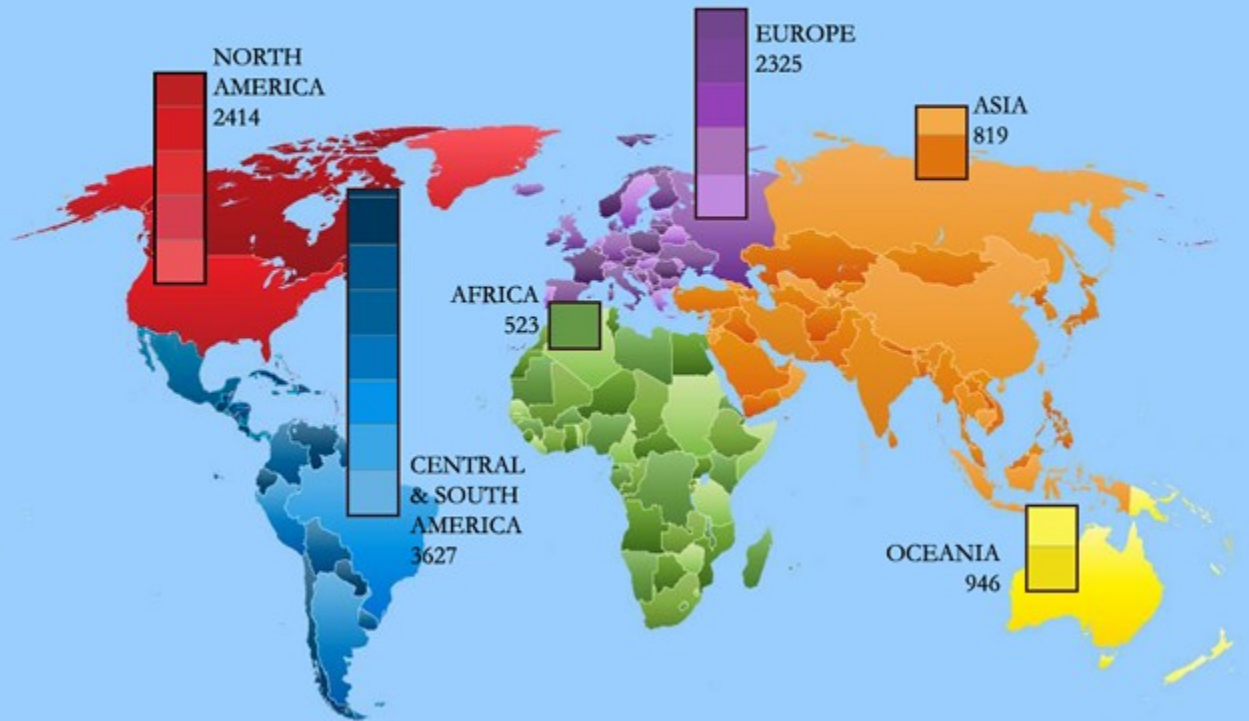

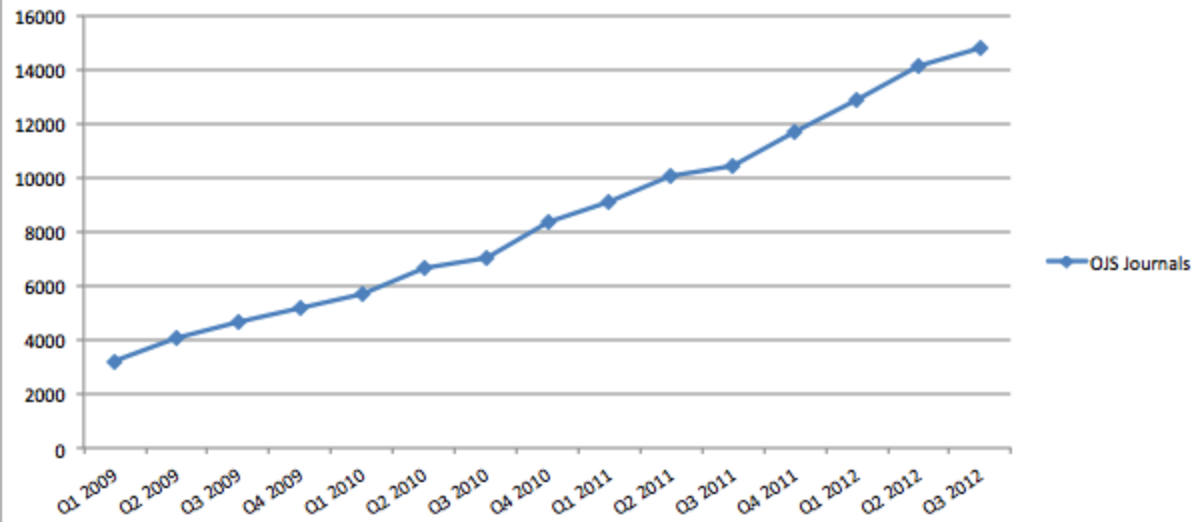

# Open Access publishing in Lithuania and Serbia: Case studies

EIFL has provided small grants to support Open Access publishing initiatives in Lithuania and Serbia and now Eleonora Dagiene, Chair of the Council at The Association of Lithuanian Serials, and Pero Šipka, CEON/CEES, describe the results.

## Promoting Open Access through Implementation of Open Journal Systems (OJS) in Lithuanian Research Journals: A Case Study from Lithuania:



Key achievements:

- Over 130 participants involved in publishing attended training events and learnt about OJS and on-line publishing. Seminar materials are available from the website of the Association.
- Lithuanian OJS version and guidelines for journal editors and publishers have been released and disseminated.
- Digital Object Identifier (DOI), and Cited By (by crossref.org) have been added to the OJS installations in the Lithuanian and English languages. Promoting plagiarism detection tools (CrossCheck) (by crossref.org and iThenticate).
- 22 OJS installations (and counting) implemented at seven research institutions:
  - Vilnius Gediminas Technical University (VGTU): Coactivity: Philology, Educology ; Coactivity: Philosophy, Communication ; Business: Theory And Practice ; Science - Future of Lithuania ; Evolution of Science and Technology ; Business, Management and Education
  - The Lithuanian Statistical Society: Lithuanian Journal of Statistics
  - The International School of Law and Business: Current Issues of Business and Law

## Open Journal Systems: Possibilities of the Lithuanian Research Journal Distribution

Tuesday, 29 March 2011 14:48

The aim of the project is to acknowledge the Lithuanian research journal publishers and editorial boards with *Open Journal Systems* (OJS) which is a wide-spread research journal electronic publishing system and encourage them to use this system for publishing and distribution of the Lithuanian research journals. This project will include workshops which will be organized in Vilnius, Kaunas and Šiauliai. The participants of the workshop will learn about the *Open Journal Systems* methods for on-line management of all the research journal publishing stages, from manuscript submission to their publishing. Moreover, digital object identifiers (DOI) and possibilities of implementing plagiarism prevention (*CrossCheck*) system for the Lithuanian journals will be presented at the workshop.

A trial journal version in English and Lithuanian will be prepared for the purpose of the project and guidelines for journal editors will be published. In order to attract the attention of more editorial boards of the Lithuanian journals, more detailed information about the project will be announced at the workshops organized by the Association of Lithuanian Serials as well as local and international scholarly conferences.

# Цифровий ідентифікатор об'єкта

**Цифровий ідентифікатор об'єкта** (англ. *digital object identifier*, скорочено **DOI**) — сталий ідентифікатор, який надається електронному документу. Подібно до **URN**, але на протигагу **URL**, не залежить від місця знаходження документа. Міжнародний фонд DOI (англ. *International DOI Foundation*), визначає поняття назва *DOI* як «цифровий ідентифікатор для довільного об'єкта інтелектуальної власності»; та розтлумачує, що DOI використовується для «сталогі ідентифікації зразків інтелектуальної власності в цифровій мережі та асоціювання структурованих даних в розширюваний спосіб.»<sup>[1]</sup> DOI є зареєстрованою **торговою маркою** IDF.<sup>[2]</sup> Типовим застосуванням DOI є ідентифікація наукових документів та статей.

## Структура

DOI складається із унікального рядка літер та цифер, що складається з двох частин: префіксу, та суфіксу.

Приклад повного DOI:

**10.1000/182**

де:

**10.1000** є префіксом:

**10** кодом каталогу. Код каталогу має бути числом; коректні коди каталогів визначаються агенціями з підтримки (IDF). Наразі, єдиним кодом каталогу є 10, і всі коректні DOI починаються з «10.».

**1000** є кодом реєстратора або *ідентифікатором видавця*, який ідентифікує реєстратора. В цьому випадку, цей код ідентифікує IDF.

**182** є суфіксом, або *ідентифікатором екземпляра*, який ідентифікує окремих об'єкт. (звичайні суфікси довші за наведений приклад.) В цьому випадку, об'єкт, що відповідає doi:10.1000/182 є «DOI Handbook, Version 4.4.1».

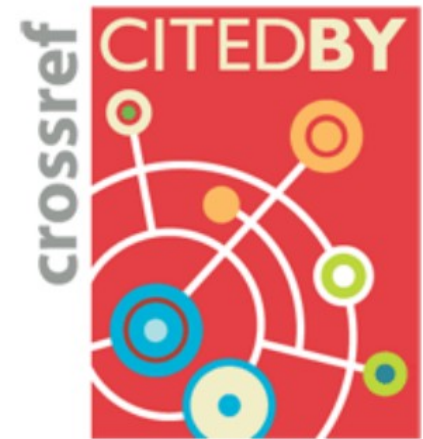
Префікс надається агенцією з реєстрації DOI (англ. *DOI Registration Agency*) окремим реєстраторам. Суфікс надається реєстратором і має бути унікальним в контексті цього префіксу. До нього можуть входити стандартні ідентифікатори, такі як **ISBN**, або **ISSN** або **SICI**. DOI не залежить від реєстру літер.

## MEDFLY AREAWIDE STERILE INSECT TECHNIQUE PROGRAMMES FOR PREVENTION, SUPPRESSION OR ERADICATION: THE IMPORTANCE OF MATING BEHAVIOR STUDIES

### Abstract

The Sterile Insect Technique (SIT) is amongst the most non-disruptive pest control methods. Unlike some other biologically-based methods it is species specific, does not release exotic agents into new environments and does not even introduce new genetic material into existing populations as the released organisms are not self-replicating. However, the SIT is only effective when integrated on an areawide basis, addressing the total population of the pest, irrespective of its distribution. There has been considerable progress in the development and integrated application of the SIT against the Mediterranean fruit fly (medfly), *Ceratitis capitata*, as reflected by operational programs for prevention, suppression and eradication of this pest. There is however, considerable scope for improving the efficiency of medfly SIT, an indispensable requirement for increased involvement of the private sector in any future application. One way to achieve this has been the development of genetic sexing strains, making it possible to release only sterile males. Another is improving sterile male performance through a better understanding of the sexual behavior of this insect. Unlike other insects for which the SIT has been successfully applied, medfly has a complex lek-based mating system in which the females exert the mate choice selecting among aggregated and displaying wild and sterile males. With the objective of developing a better understanding of medfly mating behavior, an FAO/IAEA Coordinated Research Project was carried out from 1994 to 1999. Some of the resulting work conducted during this period with the participation of research teams from ten countries is reported in this issue.

## What is CrossCheck?

CrossCheck powered by **iThenticate** is an initiative started by CrossRef to help its members actively engage in efforts to prevent scholarly and professional plagiarism. Although there are several plagiarism screening tools already available, they are not well-suited to filtering academic content simply because they haven't had access to the relevant full-text literature to screen against. CrossCheck changes this by creating and continuously growing a database of current and archival scholarly literature.



This database is one of two parts that make up the CrossCheck service. The second part is the **iThenticate tool**, which compares authored work against the content in the database and highlight matching or similar text for further editorial review.

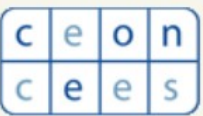

e-Ur is based on the *Open Journal Systems (OJS)*, an open source platform developed within the *Public Knowledge Project (PKP)* which is used worldwide. CEES version is thoroughly adapted to the needs of local users and strengthened with services dedicated to the quality control and assurance of research articles.

The current version of e-Ur provides:

- online submission of articles and tracking of review process;

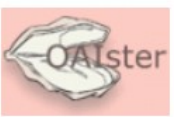
